February 23, 2016

Jane Hansen called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. and roll call was taken.

Scottie Ard moved to adopt the agenda as presented, seconded by Jim Jackson and carried.

### **Bedbug Complaints and Strategies**

Mike Darrow explained there has been an ongoing issue with bedbug complaints in various locations around the City. Depending upon the facility type, there are different rules and regulations regarding infestations but no statutory language which specifically addresses bedbugs. Discussion followed on the consequences of infestations and possible ways to correct the problem. Scottie Ard moved to allow Nick Vivian to construct language for a nuisance ordinance in regards to bedbugs, seconded by Jim Jackson and carried.

### **Loyalty Day Update**

The second annual Loyalty Day is scheduled for April 30<sup>th</sup>. The theme this year is "Welcome Home". Loyalty Day honors all veterans with a special emphasis this year on Vietnam Vets. Scottie is working with Crowning Achievements; an organization for the developmental disabled as an added event to promote community involvement. Business will be notified that streets will be closed at 1:30 p.m. Scottie announced that New Richmond will host the 2018 Wisconsin State VFW parade.
