



### **Outcome Examples Presentation – Todd Streeter**

Todd presented a series of examples demonstrating different ways of creating a final CAP reflecting the committee's ideas, concepts and recommendations. Examples included a typical Comprehensive Plan, an appendix from another Comprehensive Plan outlining approximately 25 community recommendations, and a downtown revitalization project's presentations showing issues and recommended concepts. Members noted these examples were very helpful.

Committee chairs reported on the growing list of ideas, issues and challenges they have identified through their interaction and research.

### **Subcommittee Breakout Session**

Members focused on developing important CAP statements required in the project. The committees will draft vision and value statements and guiding principles supporting the desired direction of their work and final recommendations.

Committee chairs will be providing presentations including research, maps and images that demonstrate many of their ideas and concepts. This "show and tell" will include their draft vision and value statements and guiding principles. A large group workshop will allow committees to see how their work ties into the work of other committees to form a loose composite picture of the larger project.
